Derek reported things are running smoothly. Waiting for the CAD integration to be complete before more accurate data can be reported.

Co. 1 has consistently provided at least a driver or provider during the minimum staffed hours.

#### **New Business**

#### **County Commission Meeting**

Derek reported to the Commission that the new website would be live next week. It will be accessible from the Hardy County website, but will be managed by HCEAA.

Derek also presented the Commission with a response to the "public inquires" that were made last month. This consisted of six pages of narrative and six appendixes, totaling 45 pages. Paul reported there are \$3 million available from the state for EMS and Fire Service. He is not sure how the money will be distributed.

Derek reported he gave information to County Clerk Gregg Ely for the West Virginia Open Checkbook.

#### Invoices

Derek reviewed the invoices for September.

He reported the September check sent to PEIA was lost. A replacement was created and a stop payment issued for the check. He has completed paperwork for automatic withdrawal. Doug questioned the CAD Integration line item - \$6,840.00. Derek said the system will upgrade data collection. It will provide more specific information than the 911-center can provide regarding each call. The upgrade is the result of a Freedom of Information Act request by a citizen. Fran moved and Jay seconded a motion that payment for the CAD Integration be held until more information can be provided to the board. The motion was approved with one nay vote. Derek will have Assistant Executive Director Nathan Kesner provide further information. Fran moved and Tim seconded a motion to approved the remaining invoices for September. The motion was approved.

Billie Jo Biddle asked how the calls to Wardensville are counted if HCEAA is providing a unit.
